

Recently, Grand Lodge announced the winners of the Legacy Scholarship, which awards a \$4,000 scholarship to children and grandchildren of Elks members. Our State Association had a total of 6 winners throughout MD, DE, & DC.

Kyra Obert is a 2023 Legacy Scholarship recipient, and

the only winner from Kent Island Lodge. She is the daughter of Barbara and David Obert of Kent Island.

A senior at St. Mary's High School, she will attend the University of Denver in the fall, where she will be a Nationally ranked #3 Lacrosse team member.

She is always eager to volunteer at Elks Camp Barrett. Among her many accomplishments, Kyra is a leading straight-A student, executive vice president of the student government, co-

President of the National English Honor Society, and a silver medal winner in the National Spanish Exam.

On the field, she was named All-Conference in Volleyball and Indoor Track & Field, where she was team MVP, holding three school records. Congratulations, Kyra, from everyone at the Kent Island Elks.

More than 22,000 students applied for the Elks National Foundation's **Most Valuable Student scholarship**, but only 20 interviewed for the six top awards of up to \$50,000. On April 13-16, the 2023 Top 20 Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student National Finalist met in Chicago at the first in-person Leadership Weekend since 2019.

Our State Association had 3 of the top 20 Scholarship Winners. According to ENF, this is the FIRST time both first place winners came from the same State Association.
