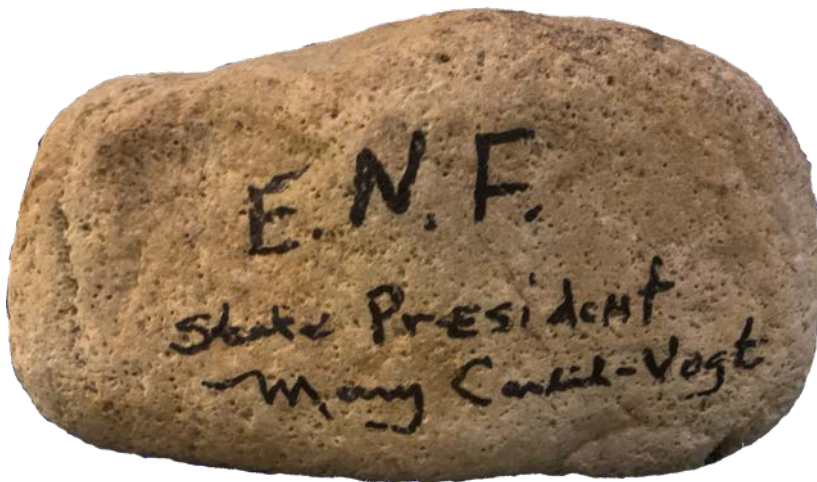

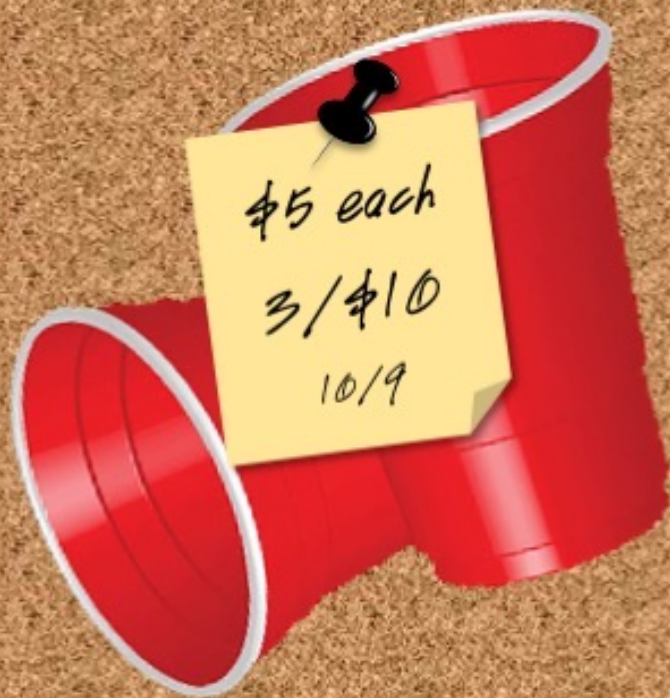

## Legacy Awards

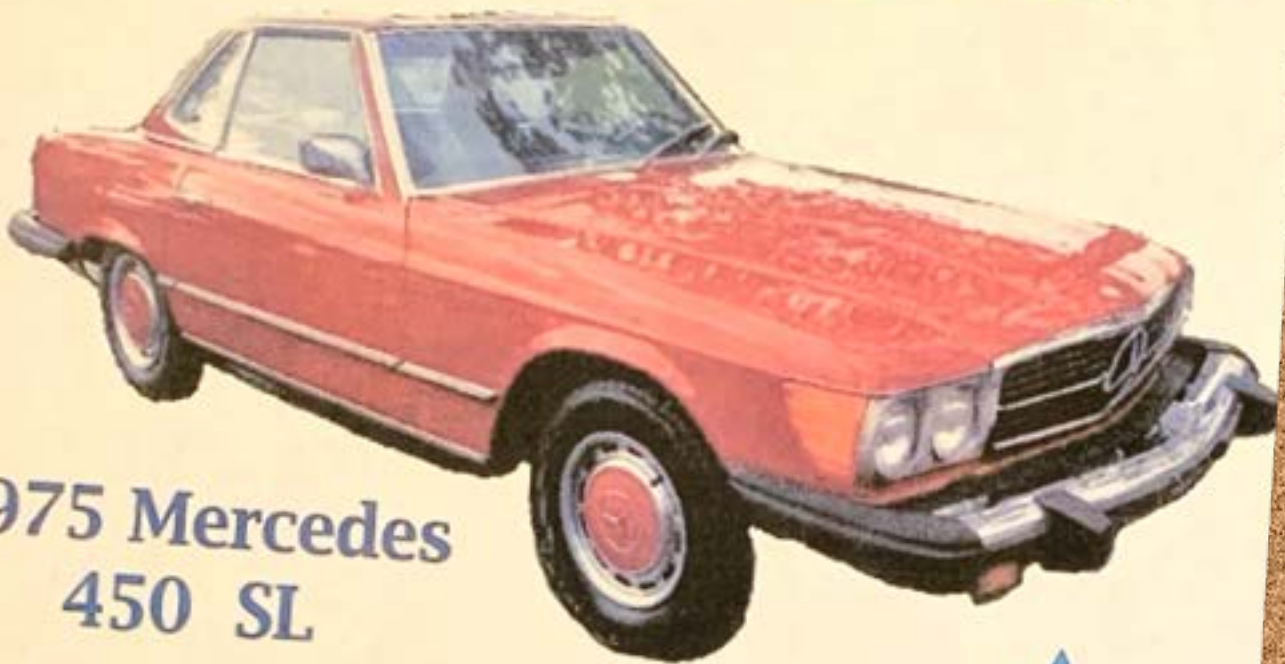
Opens Sept 1, Deadline is February 7, 2022
