Spencer Award Recipient Bio and Abstract: Dr. Atanu Biswa "From Plants to Plastics"

Atanu Biswas is a Lead Scientist with USDA at Peoria, IL. He earned his PhD from the University of Notre Dame, USA. After a postdoctoral stay at the University of Virginia, Charlottesville VA, he joined Hercules Incorporated as a chemist.

As he resides in Peoria, IL, the Corn and Soybean Belt of the United States, his goal has always been to enhance the utilization of corn and soybeans. His presentation is based on research dealing with expanded uses of the components of corn, such as starch, protein, fiber, and oil. Past and ongoing research work includes chemical and enzymatic modifications of renewable resources to produce new bio-based materials | Inside this issue: and value-added products, pioneering polymer synthesis and modification work in development of bio-based plastics, coatings, films, hydrogels, absorbents, and biolubricants from agricultural products such as polysaccharides, vegetable oil, protein, edible beans, cotton, agricultural byproducts, etc. by utilizing green chemistry technologies such as microwave, ionic liquid, enzyme, extrusion etc. His research emphasizes creativity, collaboration and teamwork in developing new bio-based products. The presentation will cover his research achievement which spans both private and government (USDA/ARS) sectors.


