



The program awards renewable scholarships to underrepresented minority students from the high school seniors to undergraduate students majoring in chemistry-related disciplines, and are also intending to pursue careers in chemistry-related fields. Selected recipients are awarded up to \$5,000* per academic year.

To date, over 3,000 students have received funding from the ACS Scholars Program. Application deadline is March 1st.


