Whereas

- Both parties acknowledge the increasing global demand for verifiable ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) data, aligned with international frameworks such as GRI, IFRS, COSO, ISO, and UN SDGs.
- EMJ.LIFE has developed the SDGS PASS + NTCC + PADV methodology to capture, verify, and report on participation-based sustainability actions.
- Verification institutions play a critical role in ensuring the accuracy, transparency, and credibility of such data for corporate disclosures, investor reporting, and regulatory compliance.

The parties hereby agree to cooperate as follows:

1. Purpose of Cooperation

- 1.1 Establish a verification partnership to integrate third-party audit mechanisms into SDGS PASS data reporting, enabling verifiable alignment with ESG, SDGs, and carbon accounting standards.
- 1.2 Jointly promote internationally recognized data assurance protocols that enhance stakeholder trust and cross-border recognition of ESG participation metrics.



2. Scope of Cooperation

- 2.1 Party B shall provide Party A with access to relevant SDGS PASS participation records, NTCC conversion data, and PADV methodological documentation for audit and verification purposes.
- 2.2 Party A shall review, assess, and validate SDGS PASS-related data using its accredited verification methodologies, ensuring compliance with agreed international standards.
- 2.3 Both parties may co-develop standardized verification templates and ESG disclosure modules applicable to corporate, institutional, and governmental reporting.
- 2.4 Collaborative participation in industry forums, seminars, and public communication to advocate for the adoption of verifiable ESG participation data.

3. Data Use, Confidentiality, and Visibility

- 3.1 Party A shall have access only to data relevant to agreed verification activities, with strict adherence to confidentiality and data protection requirements.
- 3.2 Any public disclosure of verification results shall require prior written consent from both parties.
- 3.3 Both parties may be acknowledged as strategic partners in official publications, provided such references are mutually approved.

4. Term and Renewal

- 4.1 This MOU shall take effect from the date of signing and remain valid for one (1) year.
- 4.2 Unless terminated by written notice at least 30 days prior to expiration, this MOU shall automatically renew on a yearly basis.
- 4.3 This MOU outlines the mutual intention to collaborate and is not legally binding; specific verification assignments will be governed by separate contractual agreements.

5. Miscellaneous

- 5.1 Amendments to this MOU shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.
- 5.2 Electronic signatures or official stamps shall be deemed valid for the purposes of this MOU.
