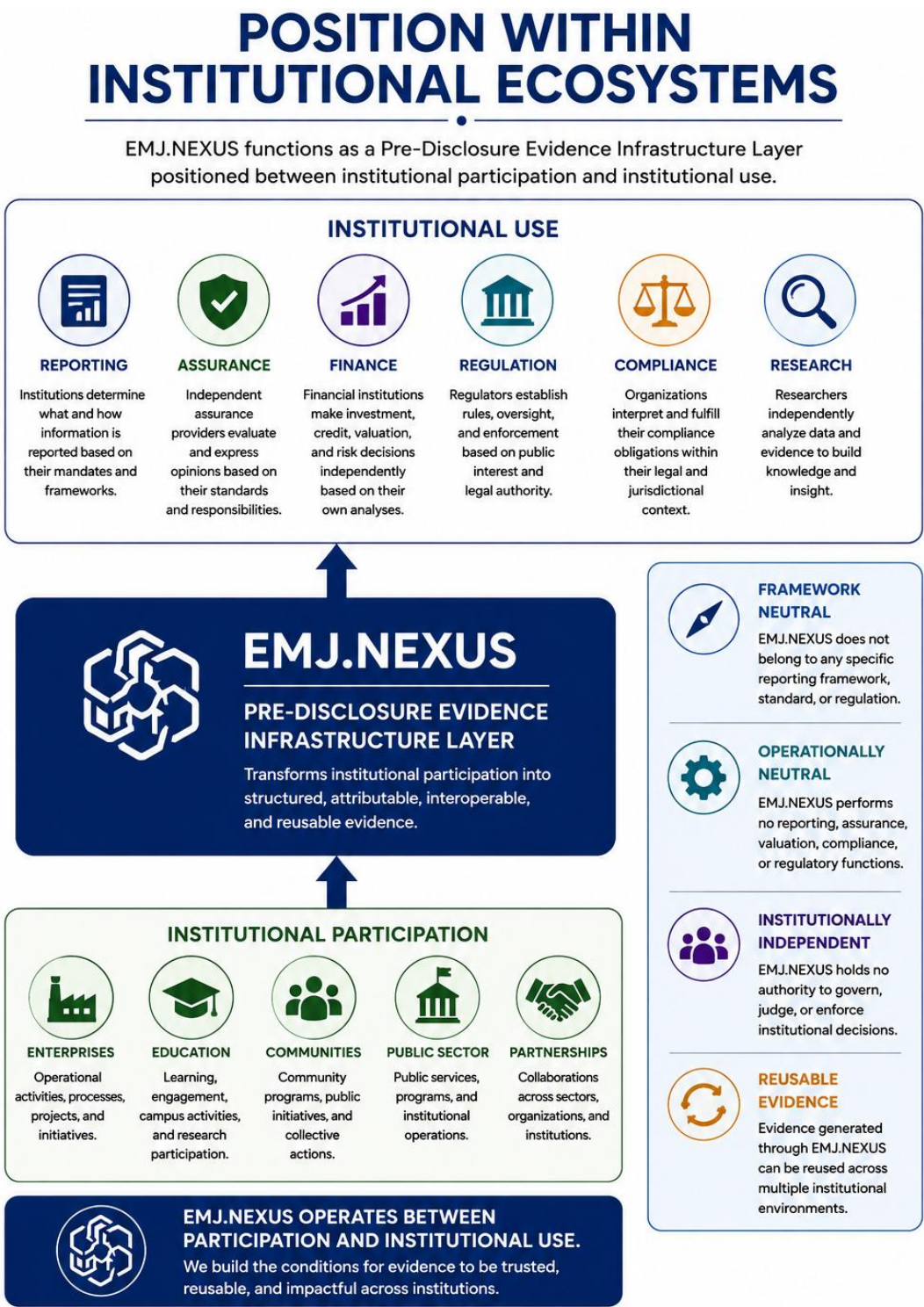


Figure 5. Position Within Institutional Ecosystems

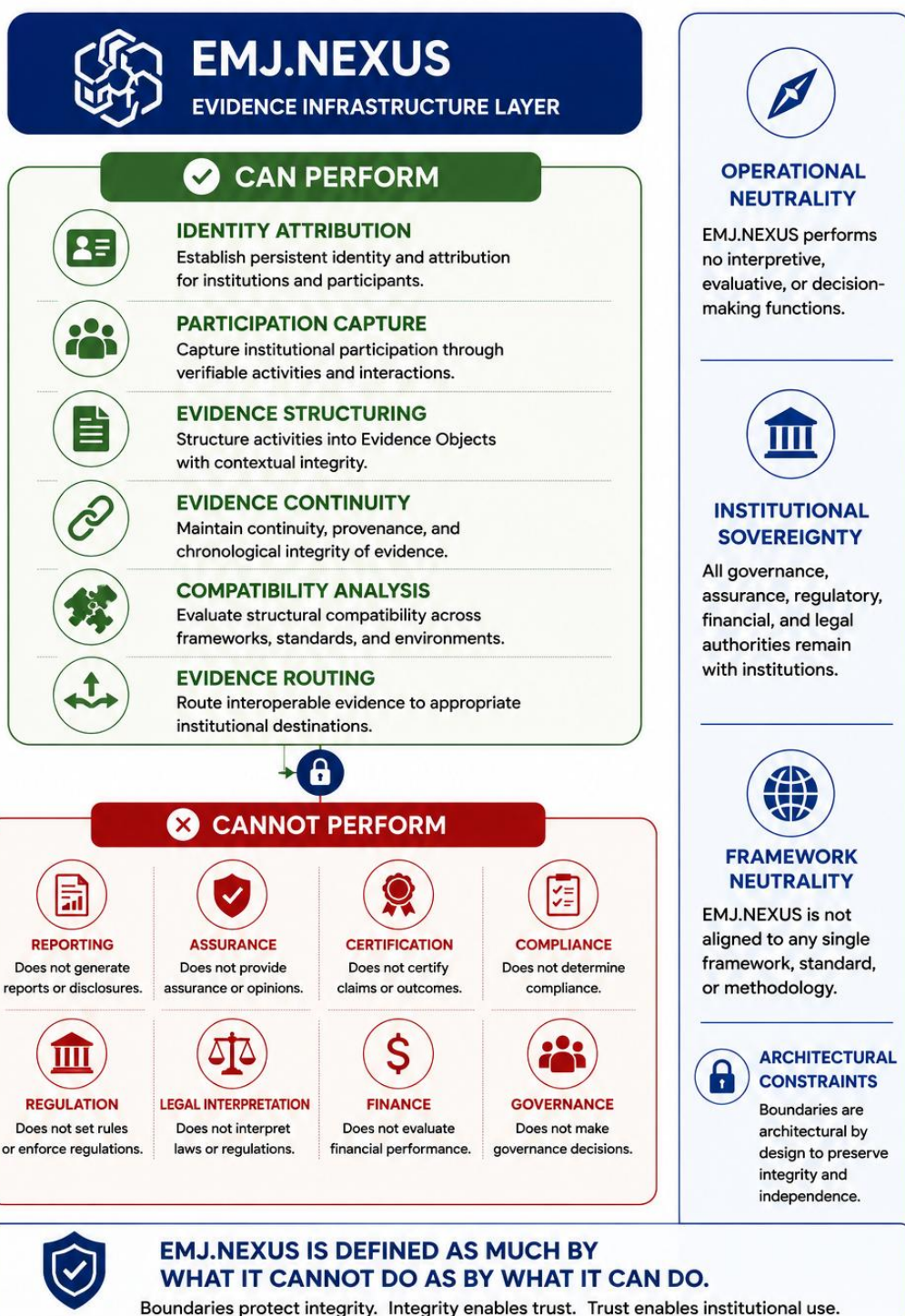

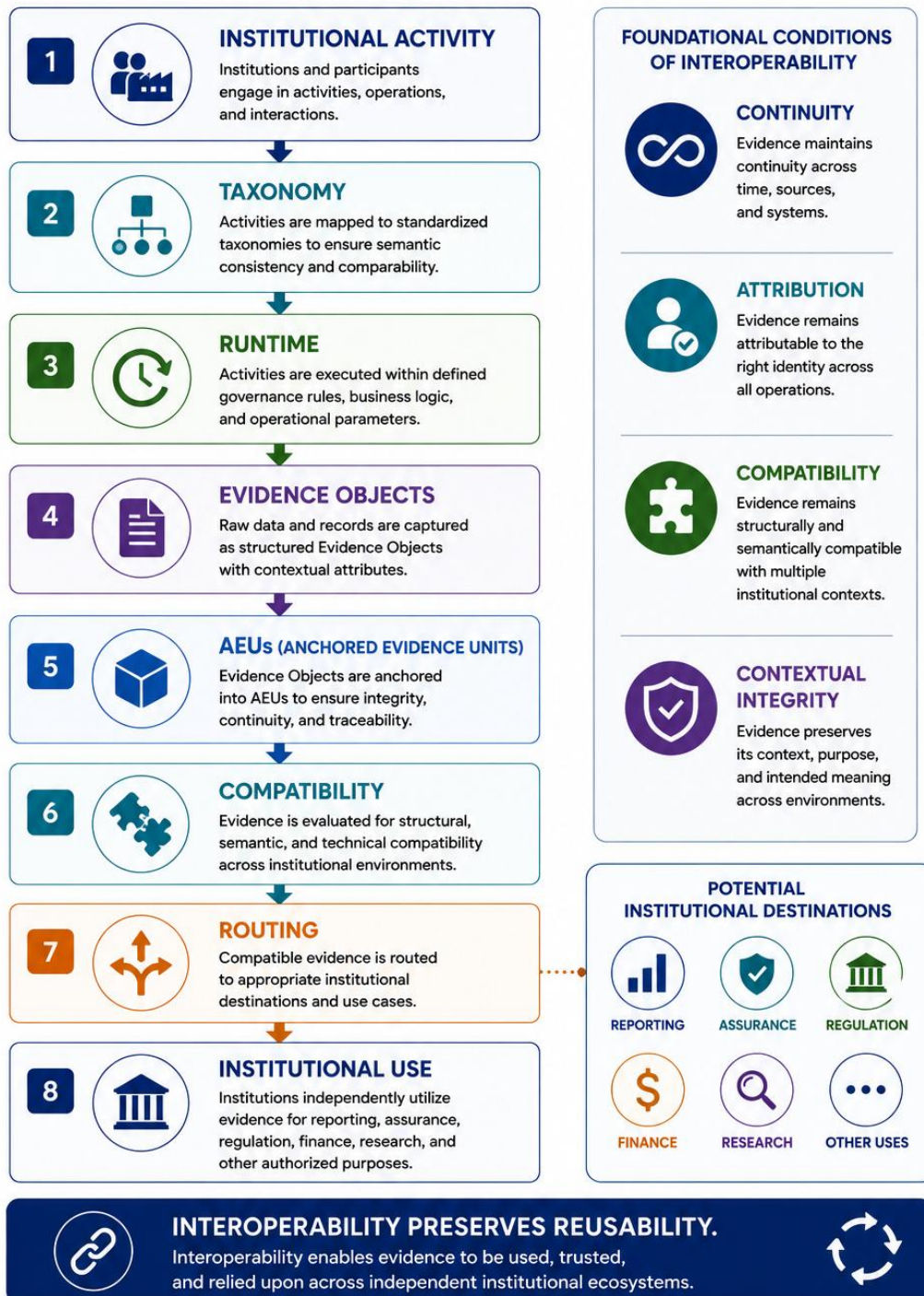

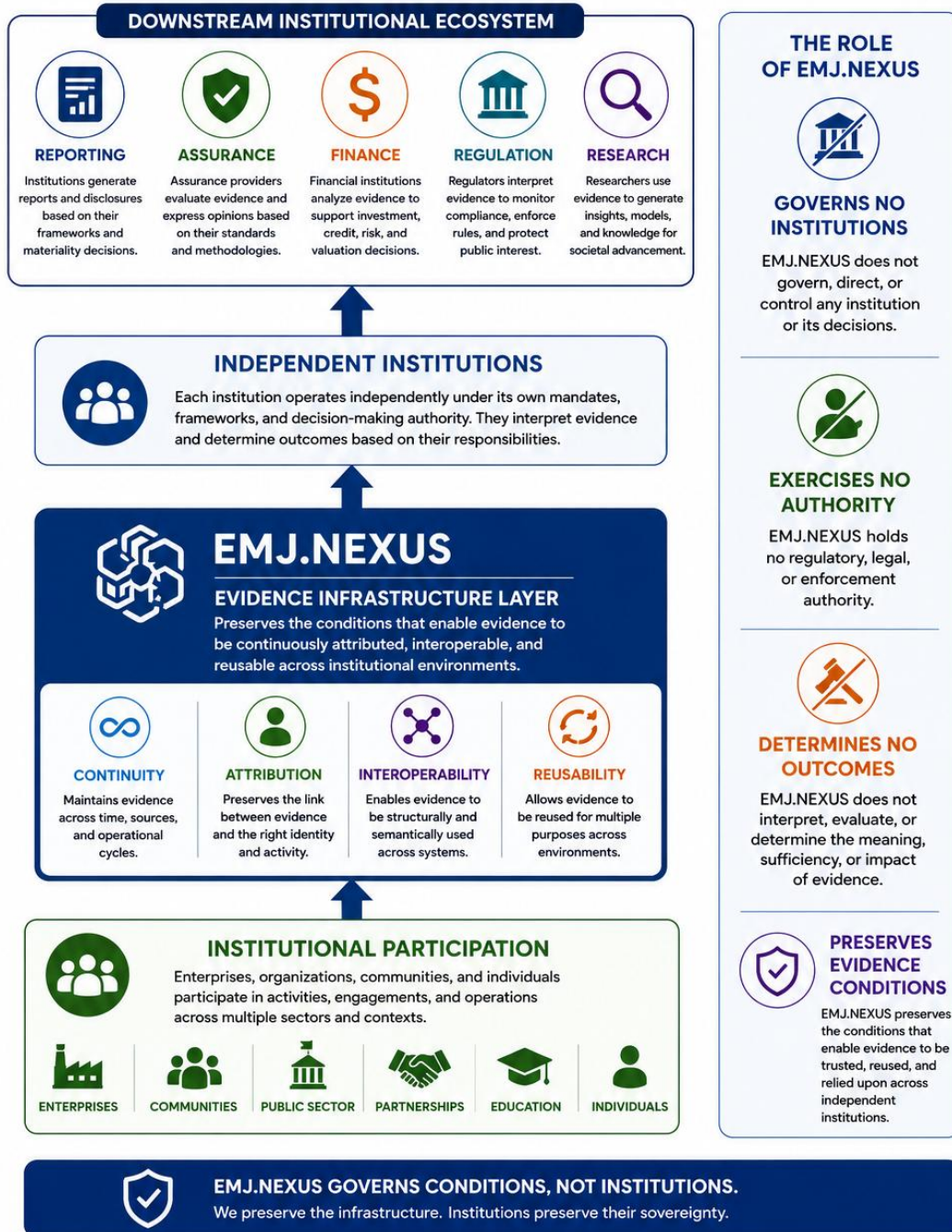
