#### **CALL TO ORDER**

- Mark plans to solicit additional corporate sponsors over the next few months. He is going to leverage the list from the Sienna Baseball League as a starting point.

#### Volunteers – We CONCESSIONS (Tiffany Pemberton)

- Basketball is in full swing.
- Volunteers We continue to struggle to get volunteers....
  - o Basketball Season
    - We have 4 home games remaining in the month of December.
    - We currently have coverage for the JV Women and Fresh/Soph Men
    - We NEED the JV Women's parents to cover the freshman games and Fresh/Soph Men's parents to cover the JV Men's games.
  - o 6 volunteer spots per Home Game for Men; 4 volunteer spots per Home Game for Women Men's games are a lot busier.
  - o If we do not have volunteers secured (especially for JV) by 1pm on gameday, the concession stand will not open.
- Concession profits How it works.... And why everyone should be volunteering...
  - o 50% to the general fund
  - o 50% to sports based on volunteer hours.

- o Booster started stocking the concession stands in October.
- O Volleyball is not included in the example because their funds stayed separate due to stocking and volunteering w/in the team.
- For this example and simplicity, let's say the Concession stands have made
  \$10,000 in profit.
  - \$5,000 would go to the general fund; \$5,000 would be split across the volunteer hours.
  - To date, we have had 124 volunteer hours recorded -- \$5000 / 124 hours = \$40.32 per volunteer hour.
  - Football (56) \$2,258
  - Baseball (52) \$2,097
  - Men's Basketball (9) \$363
  - XCountry (4) \$161
  - Women's Basketball (3) \$121

## PIZZA @ LUNCH (Angie Smith)

- Goal to start selling pizza in January.
  - o FBISD/ACHS Approval status forms will be completed this week
  - O Papa John's in Sienna will handle the Pizza. Note the price of pizza has gone up to \$9 per pizza.
  - o Pizza will be sold every Wednesday at Lunch
  - O Volunteers are needed. We understand this is a big ask since it is during the day. Coaches are also encouraged to help.
  - O We will only be accepting cash. Given the fast lunch periods, we want to make sure the lines move quickly. NO cash app, NO credit cards. CASH ONLY!
  - o Pizza will be sold for \$2 per slice or \$15 a pizza.

• All sports can order and directly sell any merchandise that is specific to their sport. (i.e., "Crawford Tennis" t-shirt, "Crawford Basketball" shorts, etc.). Revenues for these sales are deposited into Crawford Booster's bank and are credited toward the specific.
