  - Bylaws Article IV.F. point 2 “Meets regularly with Associate Delegates” → “Meets regularly with Associate Delegates through at least one roundtable each semester”
2. Rewording sister sorority events to prevent profit shares, should be an activity on campus
  - Bylaws standing rules Article IV.B.iii. “Each sorority must host 1 event with their sister sorority each semester. ☐ SUGGESTION:“ Standing Rules Article V: Order Determination for Bid Day themes and Formal date selection:

- A. Following the end of the academic semester, each sorority is ranked against other Panhellenic sororities based on their average chapter GPA. This ranking is averaged across the two semesters following the end of the prior formal recruitment and weighted at a 1/3 value in the determination of bid day release order. B. Following the end of the academic semester, each
- sorority is ranked against other Panhellenic sororities based on the number of conduct cases (infractions plus alcohol violations) found in violation. [...] This ranking is averaged across the two semesters following the end of the prior formal recruitment and weighted at a 1/3 value in the determination of bid day release order. C. Panhellenic Participation is weighted at a 1/3 value in the determination of bid day release order. For each Panhellenic Participation event, the
- VP of Member Development will take the chapter's attendance as a percentage of the chapter's billable total for the semester the event took place. In June prior to recruitment, all Panhellenic Participation events attendance percentages for the academic year (following the previous formal recruitment) will be averaged by chapter and ranked. D. Within each category, every chapter will be ranked 1st to 13th place, with 1st place being highest GPA, lowest number of infractions, and highest panhellenic participation percentage. 1 point
- is awarded to 1st place, 2 points to 2nd place, and so on. For each chapter, the points from each category will be added to find the chapter total, and the chapter with the lowest number of points will place 1st overall (and so on). E. The rankings come into effect when chapters submit their top three preferences for Bid Day themes and Formal date selection. The chapter with the higher ranking will have first preference, and the lower ranking duplicates will receive their next choice.

☐ The Bid Day theme submissions must include the chapter's top three ranked choices, each with mood boards, t-shirt mockups, and theme names. This submission will include all details and photos sent to the chapter members.

- F. In the event of a tie within one category, each chapter receives the same amount of points and the next position is skipped (1, 2, 3, 3, 5, 6...). In the event of a tie when combining categories, panhellenic participation will be given priority.”
