VII. New Business

- Presentation about Phi Mu bylaw exception
 - Please consult with your Panhellenic Delegation at the headquarters level!
 - Phi Mu is asking that the seniors they recruit during this COB process be exempt from their total calculation
 - Total is currently 237 women
 - So this would mean that Phi Mu could recruit 237 freshmen, sophomore, and juniors, and any seniors they recruit on top of that would not count towards that total
 - President: "Can I get a motion to open the floor for new business?"
 - KKF motions to open the floor.
 - AΔΠ seconds.
 - President: "So what questions do we have about the bylaw exception?"
 - AOP: "How long is this going to last? Is this just going to be until next recruitment or is Phi Mu not going to count their seniors until they get to a certain point?"
 - President: "It would just be for this recruitment. The thought behind it is that these seniors are graduating in a year so the attrition wouldn't be as great for them once they graduate those seniors."
 - AΔΠ: "Do you know if they're anticipating trying to take around an equal number of women from each grade level or is this just dependent on how many seniors they choose to give bids to?"
 - President: "I mean, I wouldn't assume that they would take 237 divided by 4 number of seniors, which is like 60 something seniors, but I would assume that they would take a decent number of the seniors that do apply. They're intending to, based on what I know about their extension

process, they usually try to interview about twice as many women as they end up taking. That's what I know about that process, so I would assume that that is what that would look like in terms of numbers."

- Advisor: "I don't know if they have an exact prescription, I know they told Sydney..."
- VP Recruitment Operations: "They said that their goal is 10-20, but if they get a huge bump in numbers that could go up."
- Advisor: "There is no prescription to it, I think the intention is that they want it to feel like every other chapter where the freshmen, sophomores, and juniors all get to view what a senior experience looks like and get to see what it would look like to transition seniors into alumni status, and so they will likely recruit seniors regardless, but it's up to you all to set the parameters around whether or not those women count towards total."
- President: "Does anybody have anything else they want to know?"
- ΑΟΠ: "Is this for seniors that are graduating in May or in December? How are they categorizing those women?"
- President: "Wouldn't it just be anyone who's classified as a senior?"
- Advisor: "Anyone who classifies as a senior, so if they come back for a fifth year or if they graduate in December, I think either one. These are important questions because it's a big decision you all are making, so trying to make a decision that suits our existing chapters well but also supports Phi Mu, and in some ways, those two points may be in contention. So how do we support the chapters that we have while also supporting Phi Mu, and you all have to ask those questions to outline that."
- President: "And assuming that Phi Mu does take around 10 to 20 seniors, or whatever that may look like, it creates a little bit of a disparity for chapters that are currently going through the COB process because now you have this balancing of different options, right, so thinking about how it will impact any number of chapters that currently exist versus Phi Mu. Anything else? Is there a motion to close the floor?"
