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# The Process: What You Need to Know

The elections process has three phases: Application, Meet the Candidates, and Speeches.

Candidates will be evaluated by representatives of all 13 chapters throughout the entire process.

Candidates are not guaranteed an invite to Speeches.

Candidates should not discuss the elections process with individuals serving as chapter representatives (Nominating Committee/Voting Delegation).

Once the slate is formed and passed with a majority vote from all 13 chapters, we will have our 2019 Panhellenic Executive Board!

# General Qualifications

- Must be a full-time student at TCU with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA
  - May not serve concurrently as an executive officer of your respective sorority
  - Must be able to serve a complete term (one calendar year) meaning you may not study abroad or graduate any earlier than December 2019.
  - Must be in good standing with you chapter and should be classified as eligible to hold and maintain an executive council position within your respective chapter

- Office Hours: For 2 hours each week (time to be determined pending officer schedules)
- Panhellenic Exec Officer Transition: December 7, 2018 @ 9:00am- 3:00pm
- President's Retreat (President only): January 18-20, 2019
- Association of Fraternal Leadership and Values Conference (AFLV): February 7-10, 2019
- Panhellenic Exec Board Retreat: February 14th-17th OR 22-24, 2019 (We will choose one weekend, but please keep both available)
- TCU Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute (UIFI): May 13-17, 2019
- Panhellenic Executive Board Work Week and Continuing Work Time: July 29-August 11, 2018

# 2018 Panhellenic Exec



## Panhellenic President

- Overseer of Panhellenic operations
- Must have served on chapter exec or Panhellenic exec previously



## VP of Management

- Coordinates bylaws, judicial processes, elections, conferences, and Panhellenic delegates



## VP of Recruitment Operations

- Coordinates all aspects of primary recruitment
- Must have served as a Rho Gamma or on her chapter's Recruitment Team
- Must stay over summer



## VP of Finance and Administration

- Responsible for all Panhellenic expenditures and budgeting
- Keeps record of meeting minutes



# 2018 Panhellenic Exec



## VP of Member Development

- Develops values based programming for Panhellenic community
- Oversees Panhellenic scholarships and Associate Delegates



## VP of Public Relations

- Designs all publicity materials and general promotions for the Panhellenic community
- Must stay over summer



## VP of Service and Philanthropy

- Coordinates Panhellenic participation in chapter philanthropy events
- Oversees Circle of Sisterhood efforts and COS Committee



## VP of Recruitment Programming

- Oversees Rho Gammas
- Works w/ new member education
- Must have served as a Rho Gamma
- Must stay over summer

# Pending Responsibility Changes

We are currently going through our bylaw proposal process to change a few officer responsibilities.

The **VP of Finance** will potentially be responsible for planning and coordinating Exec's attendance at **AFLV** - this responsibility previously fell to the VP of Management

The **VP of Public Relations** will potentially be responsible for the monthly **Panhellenic Newsletter**

If you are interested in any of these positions, but have questions about the responsibility change - ask us your questions!

# Position Preferencing

- On the application, you may select “Willing to Serve,” “Not Willing to Serve,” or “Not Qualified to Serve” for each position
  - The more positions you are willing to serve in, the more likely you will be slated for the board
  - You may edit your preferences at any time up until speeches
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Remember that you are  
applying for exec first,  
rather than just a position.  
**It is a team dynamic!**
