Chapter Spotlight: Chi Omega!

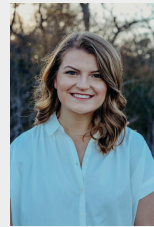
Chi Omega was awarded the Founder's Cup this summer at their convention for the third time! They are the only Chi Omega chapter to receive the award three times in a row!
