This year, Alpha Chi Omega raised \$115,000 to benefit the men, women, and children of Tarrant County with a wide variety of counseling, advocacy, and support services. Over the last 27 years, TCU Alpha Chi has given more than \$700,000 to the promotion of Domestic Violence Awareness, making them one of the top philanthropic chapters in the country!

Real Chic Women brings our community together in a unique way. Participants included men and women from all councils of our Greek community and retail

companies from the Fort Worth community loaned clothing for participants to wear.
