The Process: What You Need to Know

The election process has three phases: Application, Meet the Candidates, and Speeches.

Candidates will be evaluated by representatives from all 13 Chapters throughout the entire process.

Candidates are not guaranteed an invitation to Speeches.

Candidates should not discuss the elections process with individuals serving as Chapter representatives (Nominating Committee/Voting Delegation).

Once the slate is formed and passed with a majority vote from all 13 Chapters, we will have our 2020 Panhellenic Exec Board!

General Qualifications

- Must be a full-time TCU student and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0
- May not serve concurrently as an executive officer in your respective Chapter
- Must be able to serve a complete term (2020 calendar year) meaning you may not study abroad or graduate earlier than December 2020

 Must be in good standing with your Chapter and should be classified as eligible to hold and maintain an executive council position within your respective Chapter
