Cassie Trosino: Can we have a motion to open the floor for discussion?

ΔΔΔ: Motions to open the floor for discussion

ΔΓ: Seconds the motion.

ΔΔΔ: Question for the section 6 for voting delegation, under the new adopted bylaw that the members of the new voting delegation must be present for all components, and we must have a panhellenic delegate and a nominating committee representative, but it does not say anything about an associate delegate being present. I wanted to get confirmation to see if the associate needed to be there for all of it.

Brooke Eigenheer: Yes and no. If there is the delegate and voting member, we know that it is a huge time commitment, and we want to be respectful of everyone's time. If your associate is unable to attend, then you will still have motion to vote if there is that qualified candidate present. We do want to be convenient and convenient of everyone's time. You will still have motion to vote. If you have qualified candidate. We want to change the bylaw to make it clear that those two members must be there

ΔΔΔ: So, just that one nominating committee member and delegate is fine?

Brooke Eigenheer: Yes, however, if you are able to have the associate representing then they would also sign the contract and be there consistently have another person there, then will be okay as long as they know they have to be there consistently.

ΔΔΔ: If the delegate is not able to attend for all events except one, do they still come to the event or if they are not able to make it to the event then you can't go to any of them? Does the member have to be there, or can they go to a few sessions?

Brooke Eigenheer: If you can't make it then you need a replacement because of the training. The delegate would only see a few candidates and it would not be fair. The member has to be there for all events, it would not be fair to the candidates who are interested.

KKΓ: Chapter: I have a question about the form you gave out last time. Does just the delegate need to sign it and a member of exec who is going to be representing? I did not know the associate did not need to be there. Ideally you want three people but it's fine if you want two.

Brooke Eigenheer: It'll be like if your associate can be there, then your chapter representation would be more ideal. If there wasn't three people in the past, you wouldn't be able to sustain your vote. If we change bylaws, then you still get to keep voting obligation with two members. But if your associate can be there then she will need to sign contract.

Nichole: The member of exec comes into play if you have a member of your chapter who is a senior on exec who is not running again for panhellenic or who aren't eligible, they are the exec member that is automatically your nominating committee member.

ZTA: If you have a chapter member on pan exec, she would be nominating committee and then it would be me as the delegate and chapter president as the associate?
