NPC Update: NPC Foundation Now Accepting 2020 Scholarship Applications



The National Panhellenic Foundation recently announced that they are now accepting applications for their 2020 scholarship awards. There are six different scholarship opportunities that come to a total of \$7,000. These scholarships are open to both undergraduate and graduate women who show high academic achievement as well as actively strive to better their Panhellenic communities. Applications are due March 15, 2020.

The six different scholarship opportunities are listed below:

Alpha Phi/Betty Mullins Jones Scholarship: \$1000 awarded to a woman who actively strives to better the Panhellenic community.

Carole Jurenko Jones Scholarship: \$1000 awarded to a Panhellenic woman who has served in a chapter or Panhellenic leadership position.

Elizabeth Ahlemeyer Quick/Gamma Phi Beta Scholarship: \$2000 scholarship which requires a nomination by College Panhellenic of an individual who has provided superior service to her local College Panhellenic.

Mary Louise Roller Scholarship: \$1000 awarded to an undergraduate woman who plans to attend graduate school in the fall.

Phoenix Panhellenic Association Centennial Scholarship: \$1000 scholarship given to a woman who is in good standing with their respective Panhellenic organization.

Sigma Kappa Courage and Conviction Scholarship: \$1000 awarded to a woman that is in proper standing both academically and with Panhellenic who demonstrates "courage and conviction."
