Panhellenic Scholarships

Panhellenic is very excited to announce that we have opened the 2021 Panhellenic Scholarship Applications on Frog Scholar! The application is open until October, 12th. The winners of these scholarships will receive financial aid designated toward Spring 2022 tuition.

There are 5 scholarships available. Good luck to all who choose to apply!

New Member Scholarship: 2 recipients will be awarded \$1000 each. This scholarship revolves around the New Member experience and what a New Member hopes to receive from being a member of a Panhellenic Sorority at TCU.

Leadership and Involvement Scholarship: 2 recipients will be awarded \$1000 each. This scholarship revolves around members of the Panhellenic community that demonstrate leadership in their chapter and on campus.

Continuing Education Scholarship: 2 recipients will be awarded up to \$200 each. This scholarship acts as a 'reimbursement' to senior members of the Panhellenic community who are pursuing higher education, as this scholarship will cover the price of a graduate standardized test (GRE, MCAT, LAST, etc...)

Academic Excellence Scholarship: 2 recipients will be awarded \$1000 each. This scholarship requires a minimum 3.0 GPA and revolves around outstanding academic achievement of the applicant.

Support Scholarship: 2 recipients will be awarded \$1500 each. This scholarship aims to support members of the Panhellenic community with the highest proven need of financial aid.

6. Complete the application and click "Finish and Submit" before 11:59 p.m. Tuesday, October 12, 2021.
