Article 2.9H(a.)

Article 2. Section 9(H)

a. Solid colored cotton t-shirts will be worn by each chapter during round 1.

i. The screen print with a standard shirt color will be designed by the Panhellenic Vice President of Public Relations. The Vice President of Public Relations will present 3 design and options for the Recruitment Committee to vote on by April 1st.

1. Chapters will rank each shirt design option in order of most preferred (worth 3 points) to least preferred (worth 1 point)

2. The design/shirt with the most cumulative points will be selected as the round 1 t-shirt design.

ii. The recruitment committee will vote on whether they want to wear the official colors of their national organization or a standard shirt color by April 1st.

iii. Chapters will be billed by Panhellenic for the cost of the shirts but will not include the costs in the recruitment budget.

Article 2.9H(b.)

If we choose to each wear a different color shirt ...

1. Chapters will wear a standard shirt color, the three shirt options will be proposed and voted on by April 1st.

2. Chapters will be able to choose their shirt color based on the official colors of their national organization. Chapters may also choose from neutral colors including black and gray. Shirt colors will be chosen by April 1st. In the instance of more than one chapter wanting the same color shirt, the chapters will come to a mutual agreement or draw from a hat for first pick.

g. During the third round of Formal Recruitment, chapters shall present PNMs with individual chapter financial information along with Financial and Housing Information form.

1. PNMs are allowed to take the Financial and Housing Information form with them when they leave the chapter facility, and chapters will not face a fine.

2. The Financial and Housing Information form must be in accordance with the template provided by Panhellenic and should be submitted along with the Chapter Planning Document for review and approval.

3. ***This form will be printed by Panhellenic and delivered to your Chapter Facility before the beginning of Round 3 for Chapters to distribute***
