This meeting featured Chuck Nelson from the Figure 8 Lure Company. Chuck made his presentation to us in a very personal roundtable discussion. Chuck's resume is impressive. He is a teacher, a musky guide, and a representative for FIGURE 8 (www.figure8lurecompany.com). Chuck also was previously employed by Mepps where he was instrumental in bringing the Marabou-style to their product line. Chuck did bring a sampling of Figure 8 lures along and discussed how they work and where to use them. (This writer is getting a couple.) He surprisingly stated that we all should be looking at our own tackle boxes for older lures that you have had success with and tap them for use again, e.g. Eagle Tails and Mepps bucktails. He feels that many musky hunters have abandoned the old "reliables" that worked well for the newer, highly marketed lures. Maybe the fish are used to seeing those new ones only and would like to view some of the old, good ones. In essence, he said, Put more thought into using some of the old ones. Chuck urged everyone to look at FIGURE 8 offerings on their website and at the upcoming shows.
