He gave us an interesting discussion regarding the fishery history of Green Bay. His in depth discussion revealed the ups and downs of that fishery explaining the causes and effects of the health of this very popular fishing hole. Most of the problems have been a result of man-made habitat destruction. Jason talked about the research going on presently to help mitigate damage and where the fish are coming from namely some tributaries. Natural reproduction in the Bay is not easily proven.
