The 2023 Election of Officers process was completed. The nominated and elected officers are as follows.


President Jerry Lapine Vice President **Dave Lapine** Beth Maeder Secretary Treasurer Ron Lange

Minimum information needed:

- Lake or River
- Lure/Bait

- Length (minimum 34" for Club entry)
- Date

Our policy is to register the fish within 14 days of the catch and release. Our other policy is to release all fish safely. Photos sent to us by email or mail would be nice as well as any other data regarding your success.
