We ask each person pay \$5 for the lunch to the Club, and the Club will pay the balance and tip. Any launching fees are on the angler. We ask that you pay for any alcohol you drink separately. For those fishing on Little Green, there is a launch and bait shop known as "Landing on Little Green" W2120 Melmar Dr., Markesan, WI. This is on the southern shore and there is a \$5 fee for launching. There is another launch just west of this that is a public no fee launch. For those fishing Fox Lake there is a public launch on the north side of the City of Fox Lake in Clausen Park (fee of \$5). There is also a Town Park boat launch on the NW

Minimum information needed:

- Date
- Lake or River
- Lure/Bait

- Length (minimum 34" for Club entry)
- Include a picture when possible

Our policy is to register the fish within 14 days of the catch and release. Our other policy is to release all fish safely. Photos sent to us by email or mail would be nice as well as any other data regarding your success.
