

Mark Baldock, Fisheries Technician from the Wisconsin DNR will be here along with Phil Hansen, Board Member of the Fox Lake Preservation Organization, Inc (FLPO). Both the DNR and the FLPO were instrumental in helping us implement the stocking plan last year that we participated. Our plan this year is to work with them again. Mr Hansen will personally address us regarding the FLPO's organization and what type of conservation projects that it supports.

In reading their Articles of Incorporation we have discovered that this 501 (c)(3) has several purposes that are much in line with our goals regarding enhancement of water quality, the fishery, boating safety, and aesthetic values...for today and future generations."

Mr. Baldock will address us as to appropriate studies that the fisheries department understands about Fox Lake. He will review the processes that the fishery technicians deal with and require in making decisions on granting stocking permits for Wisconsin Lakes. Last week, Jordan Weeks from the DNR addressed the Alliance Board regarding the issues the fisheries face in order stock fish. It was revealing, the complexity of it all. The basic ideas from this presentation were that the fisheries personnel really do want to stock fish .. Outside factors like political issues, the budgetary side, the environmental science side, and best expectations for good results from stocking, are all taken in to consideration. Mr. Baldock will discuss the processes that are being considered by the fisheries department. The fisheries are on our side and want to stock fish. We need this understanding to effectively work with our fisheries friends. Hopefully we have a good membership turnout for this interesting topic. Bring a guest.

We will have a brief "lake briefing" at our Wednesday May 1st regular Club meeting.

The first MEMBER to catch and release a musky 34" or longer must call Jerry LaPine (920-517-0392) on your cell phone and leave a message about your catch (time, date, length and location).
