# April 5<sup>th</sup> Alliance Meeting Information

Mr Dan Oele, Musky Team Co Leader, from the WIDNR Fisheries Dept visited with the Alliance attendants at the recent April 5th meeting He had

a general discussion and answered questions regarding stocking and procedures. Dan presented the DNR's 2024 Muskellunge Stocking Totals for 2024. Copies will be available at our May 5th meeting. He also expressed his desire to increase communication between the Alliance and the DNR with regard to our mutual needs and wants.

- The DNR fisheries biologists for the waters you are interested in should be your starting point for clubs interested in either private stocking or DNR stocking. Your local biologist can "score" a lake for stocking and strain eligibility. There are strict rules for the stocking of eligible strains in each body of water. The DNR is sticking to their guns on musky genetics in issuing musky stocking permits! It is not easy to find available stock for the eligible strains.
- Dan informed us that the fisheries "Musky Books" new edition has been gathering
  professional data over the last few years and the new research book/pamphlets will
  be available soon.(Maybe after June 1). Many research facts and findings found in
  this book will be helpful when considering stocking and getting the most bang for our
  stocking bucks.





- There are important differences between the way clubs can provide funding for specific stocking plans. This can be discussed in more detail at our May meeting.
- The Alliance donated \$75,000 to the WI DNR Fisheries Bureau for rearing and stocking in the northern third of the state.
- Much discussion was had regarding forward facing sonar. The Alliance will not allow its use in the National Tournament in August in Eagle River. Don't panic, you don't have to remove the device from your boat, you just can't use it on your honor. See the rules and registration which we will have at our May 7<sup>th</sup> Club meeting.
- **A RULE NOT TOTALLY KNOWN** and now we do. Permits or registration is required for outings and tournaments . We will have rules available at the May 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting. As this is interpreted, our typical outings will require registration. This rule came out in 2024.

### STOCKING NOTES

The Fox Lake Preservation Organization (FLPO) and the Winnebagoland Musky Club are planning on stocking about 200 muskies in Fox Lake. This will be our third year of stocking 200 fingerlings (10-11"). The actual event when the fish will be delivered will be sometime this October 2025. We will need 3 boats with 2 or 3 large coolers, a proper size scooping net (trout net size) to transfer fish, and at least 2 people per boat. Someone for photo ops is always appreciated. This is a great project and partnership with the FLPO, a good conservation group.

We are also looking at the possibilities of stocking Elkhart Lake this year as well. Further discussion will be on the agenda for the upcoming May 7<sup>th</sup> Club Meeting.
