



2021 was another successful year helping a broad range of individuals with special needs and disabilities as we continued to broaden our reach in Arizona, New Mexico and Southern California, as well as with a wide range of individuals and organizations throughout the country. This success was driven by our Project Maestro program, which incorporates the revolutionary Beamz Interactive Music System. By simply touching light beams or virtual instruments with their hands, anyone - regardless of their age, musical experience or ability can have fun creating and playing music, or DJ'ing, while simultaneously receiving a wide variety of learning, physical, cognitive, social/emotional, communicative, and sensory skills & therapy benefits. In 2021, through Project Maestro, we donated 112 Beamz systems that provided such benefits to 1,200 to 1,700 individuals with special needs and disabilities.

Over the past six years Project Maestro has donated about 800 Beamz units, together with ongoing training and support, positively impacting over 10,500 individuals with special needs and disabilities, as follows:

- Over 270 Beamz systems were provided to teachers and schools, reaching more than 5,300 students with special needs
- Over 80 Beamz systems were provided to nonprofit organizations, including senior care and memory facilities, reaching over 2,500 individuals with special needs
- * Over 100 Beamz systems were provided to therapists, reaching about 1,500 special needs clients
- * Over 330 Beamz systems were provided to families, reaching approximately 1,000 individuals with special needs and their friends & family members

Due to COVID, in 2021 we were not able to attend trade shows as we have in the past, and our IOS Beamz Systems were out of stock so we were limited to supporting individuals with PC computers only. However, we were very successful in spreading the word via networking with our existing donees and participating organizations along with social media and various special needs organizations and groups. We also continued to provide training (often virtual) to - and partnered with - several organizations and professionals that serve individuals with a wide range of special needs and disabilities (see list of participating organizations at the end of this Newsletter). We are extremely pleased that these efforts produced the above noted positive result. With the invaluable relationships, sponsorships and assistance received from others, we expect Share Your Blessings and Project Maestro to continue to grow and expand its support of a great many individuals with special needs in the years to come.

This incredible interactive musical system gives students a way to interact despite physical limitations. In addition to music there is also an array of activities to choose from including a broad range of early learning, math, music education, and interactive storybook songs, and other activities. Students can have fun playing musical instruments. regardless of musical experience or ability, or they can add sounds to songs being played by simply touching light beams with their hands. For instance, while playing the early learning song "ABC Phonics," the student can add in the letter sound, play the object's sound representing the letter in the music, or add musical instrument sounds to the song depending on which light beam he/she touches. The Beamz player would increase student engagement and participation in music and gross motor activities, provide an incentive for students to earn as a reward for completing their school work, facilitate speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and/or adapted PE sessions in order to target IEP goals, encourage fine and gross motor skills development/refinement, planning/sequencing, cause/effect, and positional awareness.
