

Sermon Notes: Practice Peace

Key Scriptures: Ephesians 2:12-18, Isaiah 9:1-7, Luke 2:8-14

Q:WHAT IS PEACE?

A: Jesus!

Greek word for peace:

<u>Eiréné</u> - peace, peace of mind; invocation of peace a common Jewish farewell, in the Hebraistic sense of the health (welfare) of an individual.

Q: HOW DO WE GET PEACE?

A: Tie yourself to Him.

Greek root words for peace:

eirḗnē (from eirō, "to join, tie together into a whole") – properly, wholeness, i.e. when all essential parts are joined together; peace (God's gift of wholeness).
