## RULES:

1. Exhibitors must follow the general rules \& policies listed in the front of this Handbook.
2. All animals will be inspected upon arrival. Clinical evidence of disease may prevent entry of the animal to the fair. Diseased animals must be removed from the fairgrounds as soon as possible. Specified guidelines for vet inspections will be provided by the division superintendent. All cattle must be from disease-free herds. Any female cattle over 4 months old that are exhibited in any non-market classes must have had a Bangs Vaccine. ALL sheep and goats MUST have a scrapie tag or tattoo, regardless of age or sex.
3. Classes are open to all counties and states.
4. Pre-entry: All livestock must be pre-entered, with entry forms and fees submitted by the pre-entry deadline.
5. Unloading/loading areas must be kept clear at all times; stock unloaded and loaded quickly and all vehicles removed to parking area.
6. Animals must be securely tied or penned at all times in their assigned places, properly fed and watered, kept thoroughly groomed, clean and in show condition, and supplied with necessary bedding.
7. Stalls and pens will be bedded when stock arrives. Owner must bed stalls after that.
8. Animals may be washed only at the wash rack.
9. To provide an attractive, inviting exhibition, all pens, stalls, pathways and approaches must be kept neat and must be cleaned before 8:00 AM each morning. All refuse matter must be dumped in the manure bunker.
10.All cages, pens and stalls must be cleaned at the end of Fair by exhibitor.
11.If entering for Exhibit Purposes only, clearly write "Exhibit Only" on Entry Sheet.
10. Exhibitors may make unlimited entries in each class or sub-class but are eligible for only two premiums in any one class or subclass. Each entry is eligible for only one
premium. All animals shown in group/special classes must have been shown in their regular classes.
11. Entries in purebred class must show a preponderance of characteristics to the breed they represent. Entries not clearly of specific breed will show in Crossbred class.
12. Base date of age by show date.
13. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper class and section for breed, variety, age and sex only. If no class is offered, no awards will be made.
14. A judge may excuse an animal from competition if it appears fatigued or out of condition.
15. Special Classes: ribbon award only.
16. Every precaution will be taken to properly protect exhibits in all departments. For this purpose a caretaker will be on duty during the fair.
17. The Fair and/or the caretaker are not responsible for losses or accidents to exhibits.
18. The superintendent's choice as to cage assignment and admittance of animals is final.

## RULES:

Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders' Association Inc. shall apply for rabbits and according to Cavies Standard Classification for Cavies, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Agriculture.
2. ANIMALS MUST BE IDENTIFIED BY EAR IDENTIFICATION CONFORMING WITH THE ENTRY FORM ON ARRIVAL AT THE SHOW. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor in the same class must be eliminated and change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
