Curry County Junior Fair Board Members

The Curry County Fair Board has two Junior Fair Board Members included on their panel. These youth are not voting members of the board. They are encouraged to share their viewpoints on agenda items being discussed by the board. Their roles include building enduring friendships and professional relationships along the way. Their personalities and experiences provide a youthful and fun perspective as they fill the role at meetings and various events being put on at the Event Center on the Beach, aka the Curry County Fairgrounds. Through this experience, they will expand their leadership development and give back to Curry County.

The Junior Fair Board Member role is designed for youth who have proven leadership abilities and are willing to take on major responsibilities including:

- Assisting the Fair Manager and staff in planning and promoting the County Fair – assists in Fair activities, show, and events.
- Assist in getting the Jr. Fair facilities ready for shows and events.
- Assist judges and superintendents with entries and show ring responsibilities during fair (unless otherwise occupied in 4-H shows) .
- Attend all regular meetings, special meetings, and special events of the Fair Board and interested sub-committees, unless conflicting school or sports events are in conflict.
- Maintain active and model membership in the organization that they are representing as a Junior Fair Board Member

To apply:

1. Members must be 13 - 18 years old by January 1 of the current year.
2. Members must be in 8 - 12 grade with the full term falling within your high school years.
3. Members will serve one (1) year terms beginning in October of each year, with the opportunity to reapply each year.
4. The Junior Fair Board is guided by one or two Curry County Fair Board members and a Curry County 4-H staff and/or 4-H Volunteer.
5. Fill out and turn in a Fair Board Member Application.
6. If selected as a Curry County Junior Fair Board Member, the youth must enroll in the Curry County 4-H Program Leadership Group.
