THE DOCTRINE OF EDU-KWONDO

The doctrine of Edu-kwondo is simple and mandatory for all students. It should be memorized and lived by all students of Edu-kwondo.

- 1. COURTESY: A person's country, flag, parents, and Instructors should be treated with the utmost respect. Courtesy and respect should be extended to all students in general and higher ranking belts in particular, as well as any other human beings.
- 2. MODESTY: Edu-kwondo students are expected to be humble about their accomplishments Braggarts and bullies have no place in the sport A feeling of pride in achievement is good but it should not be broadcast idly about.
- 3. PERSEVERENCE: From time to time, in any activity a person may become discouraged. This is particularly true if the activity is challenging enough to be truly worthwhile. One should never become a quitter. Never give up.
- 4. SELF-CONTROL: One should never lose his or her temper. Any personal skills learned over a period of time is seriously diminished if the person cannot retain control over emotions.
- 5. INDOMITABLE SPIRIT: In a way this is an expansion of all other points. An Edu-kwondo person should use the skills and education to fight injustice. One should strive to overcome personal weakness in all things and be a credit to the sport and to him/herself, always.
