Registration Classification

Our District Conference is open to all Alliance Church members and adherents, and all persons attending are expected to register. This year is a non-legislative year, but we will still maintain classifying our registrants as (1) Accredited Delegates and (2) Corresponding Delegates. All licensed Workers and Officially-Appointed- Lay-Delegates from churches, and those involved in other recognized District Committees and Auxiliary Supported Ministries are eligible to register as Accredited; All other Conference attendees must register as Corresponding.

Registration Information

The Cost is \$72 for Accredited and Corresponding delegates respectively and a discounted rate of \$52 for Retired Licensed Workers. The registration included the cost of the Banquet and one T-shirt for every delegate. After the regular registration dates, the costs will increase by \$10. Separate costs that are "add-on" to your registration are made available such as: Men's and Women's Luncheons; Banquet Only (non-delegate); RMN Chemistry Building Activity; and extra ASC imprinted T-shirts and caps for purchase are made available. The Deadline for online and mail-in registration will be completely shut down on August 31, 2023. All late registration will be accommodated at the registration check-in on September 18.
