The main goals of the discussion on the first project report were to showcase to the partners a checkpoint on the status, progress and the next steps to be taken for the implementation of the project's activities. ROUND TABLE MEETINGS

The Round table meetings are very important in the scope of the activities that are being developed in Work Package 1. It allowed to show the preliminary course structure to specialists and relevant stakeholders and collect their inputs to improve the structure.

One round table per partner country was organised by the partners. Relevant stakeholders (VET trainers and SMEs representatives) were invited to participate. 


What's next?
