What should my dancer wear to class?

Enrolled students will receive their shoe requirements and dance wear options prior to the start of dance classes. Requirements differ between age groups and are available for purchase through the studio on specific dates determined for the season. Leotards, tight fitting tank top, dance shorts/leggings or tights are acceptable for class. No loose fitting clothing that hides the hips, knees or ankles are allowed (no large t-shirts, long pants or sweat pants).

What do I do if my child is not participating or he/she isn't paying attention like the other students?

Movement education is very important in the early years of development and children have many different ways in which they process the information. If you see your student watching class more than they are dancing or perhaps twirling and fidgeting while listening to directions, this is the way they are absorbing the information. In the past 27 years I've been teaching, I can identify the students who are overloaded with the material and I may ask them to take a break. I may appear to ignore a dancer who is not participating or one who is twirling around. I am not. I am sensitive to their young minds taking in everything around them. I will always communicate with you if I do believe there is a problem.

Are there any other expenses outside of tuition?

There is an annual registration fee, dance shoes, dance wear and costumes. Costumes prices can run from \$75-\$100 each, depending on the age of the student. These prices are subject to change from season too season.

How do I pay my dance fees and when are they due?

Dance fee reminders are sent to your email on file, through the office. We can invoice you (credit card fees may apply), cash and check. We have a locked mailbox to the right of our door 104B West Main St. Morrison IL. 61270 if you'd like to mail it. All monthly payments are due on or before the 10th of the month or a \$5 late fee will be applied to the month.

How do I communicate with the teacher and/or office?

Jennifer is the only teacher at the studio and back to back classes can make it hard to have a nice conversation.
