

## **Bishop Hansel H. Henry Educational Scholarship**

1. Completion of the scholarship application.
2. Proof of current enrollment in accredited college or university.
3. Most recent college academic record including current GPA.
4. A writing sample.

**This scholarship is intended for current college students who meet the following eligibility requirements:**

- Be enrolled in a four-year degree granting college or university.
- Be in good standing with the university or college.
- Have a minimum 2.0 grade point average (GPA).
