PRIOR ART SEALS FASTENED TO TREES USING BITUMEN OR STAPLES WITH EARLY SEAL DAMAGE AND PERMANENT TREE DAMAGE















- 1. Bitumous dries as light ends evaporate, becomes harden, cracks and leaks.
- 3. Requires staples which come loose as the tree girth expands causing seals to leak.
- 5. Pleating a skirt takes time. Video show 5 minutes to install and staple a Rain Guard.
- 7. The time required to use, refill and maintain a staple gun in this envioroment is prohibited.
- 2. Seals cannot be relocated to follow cup movement hence cups are exposed.
- 4. Hardened seals are fixed to the tree impeding tree growth and damaging tree and seal.
- 6. Rain Guards with an exposed cup will not prevent tropical rains from entering the cup.
- 8. Prior art Rain Guards are not feasible due to a short life and high installation costs.
