ICY CONDITIONS

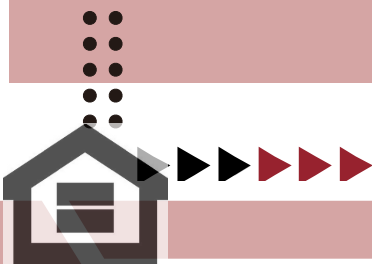

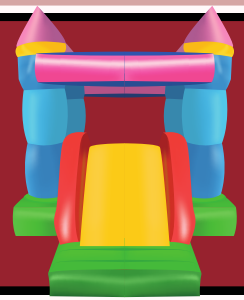
