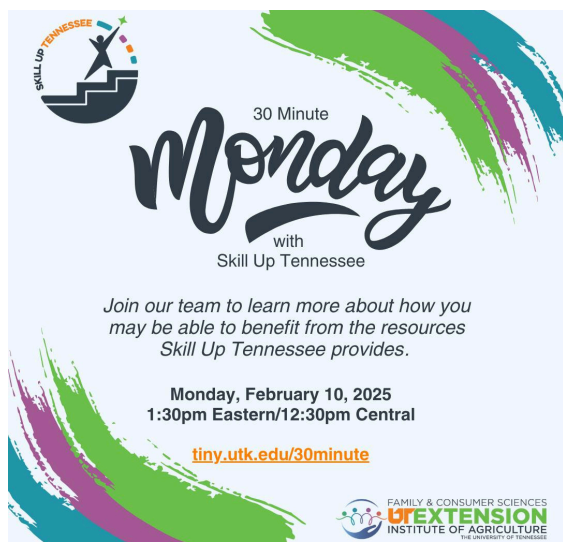
The AARP Chapter 1757 is a senior group in Clarksville that meets once a month, takes field trips and enjoy each other's company.
