## SAFETY INSPECTIONS



Inspections will continue to be done in the month of May to ensure resident safety and maintenance attention to hazardous issues. You do not have to be present. CHA team members will enter your unit and inspect the following: Blocked egresses, trip hazards, inoperable, missing, damaged, disengaged or covered smoke detectors, leaks, inoperable electrical outlets, cracked or broken outlet covers/switch plate covers, inoperable, broken or cracked toilets, or disconnected utilities. Tenants will be charged for any/all damages beyond normal wear and tear that is found during this inspection.

## Registration for the 2024-2025 School Year

If any of your children have been enrolled or waitlisted with our Head Start in the past, please do NOT submit an online application. Instead, please call one of our Family Advocates to update your family's existing profile in our system.

After you fill out the online application, you will be contacted by one of our Family Advocates to verify and complete your application. Once the application process is completed, your child will be placed on our waitlist. We will call you as soon as a slot becomes open, and your child is next on the list. If you have any questions, feel free to call one of our Head Start Centers. Our staff may be out doing home visits, so please leave a message and we will return your call shortly. Even if you are unsure whether your child is eligible, we strongly encourage all families to apply.
