- Verify Eligibility
- Ensures households still meet income and program requirements.
- Keeps housing fair and available to those who qualify.
- Update Household Information
- Record changes in income, family size, or employment.
- Helps staff provide accurate rent calculations and services.

I'm not a bird, but I fly on warm breezes; I'm bright and colorful and fall from great trees.


What am I?

Due to federal and state guidelines LIHEAP will be changing!

What is changing?

- Start of the new program year has been moved from October 1 to November 1
- All applicants <u>MUST</u> provide an email address
- LIHEAP benefit amount will be lowered (to be determined)
- To claim disability points documentation must be provided, form will be available in office if needed (does not apply to individuals receiving disability payments such as SSI, SSDI, VA Disability, etc.)
- A Verification of Income & Expenses form will be required if your household is not receiving any income, form will be available in office
