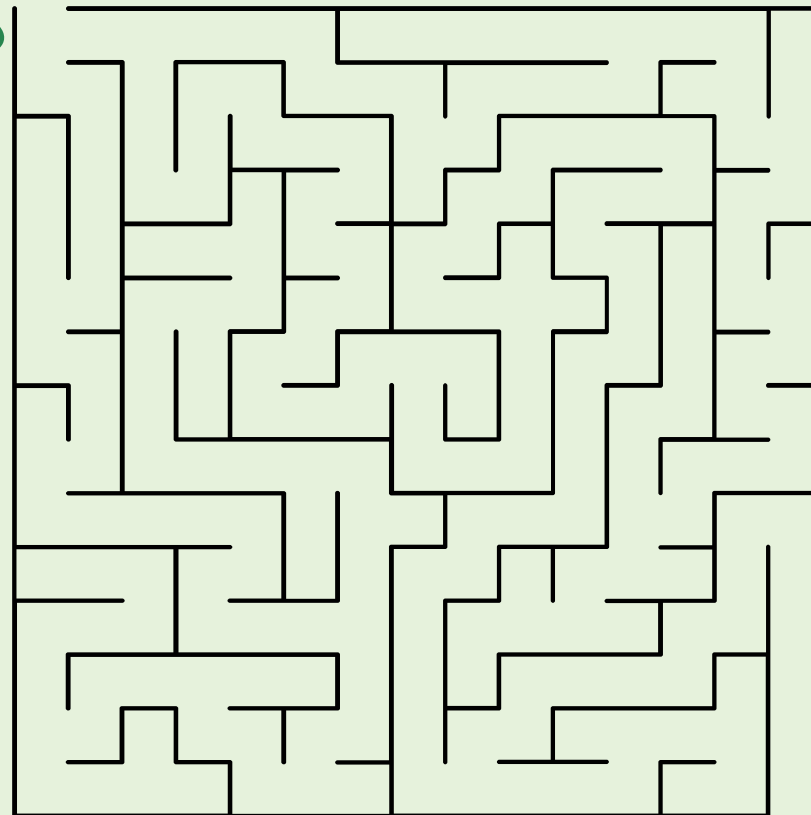

- Record changes in income, family size, or employment

- Serious water leak/burst water pipe
- Toilet wont flush if the unit has only (1) toilet. If your unit has two (2), this is not an emergency.
- Sewer back up
- Unable to lock the door.
- No heat
- No A/C ( if outside temp is 85 or higher)
- No water
