
2. ACTIVITIES DURING THE YEAR

Study & Skill Centre

 Rajrappa Charitable Foundation has established a Study and Skill Centre in the village of Hensapora, near Rajrappa, Block Gola, District Ramgarh, Jharkhand. It is housed in the building of Late Shri Ram Krishna Panda, ex Principal of Marwari School, Ranchi and receipient of the National Teachers' Award from the Hon'ble President of India. The centre has been named "Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill Centre" after him. The Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill Centre has 5 classrooms which caters to the study centre, one library, rooms for the Beauty Parlour Training and Sewing & Tailoring, two storerooms and two restrooms separate for girls and for boys. The building is for the exclusive use of Rajrappa Charitable Foundation for the Study and Skill Centre and the use is given free of cost by the owners for the welfare of the society.

• The children of the village and nearby places get free tuitions in our study centre, where the two dedicated local teachers hired by the Foundation teach and assist the children. The study centre runs from 2.30 pm till 5.30 pm after school hours. There are holidays as per the school calender except that the study centre runs and holds classes during the summer and winter vacations. The study centre complements the village school. The study centre has evinced great interest







and their parents of the village. There is only one middle school in the village. The teacher student ratio of the school is very poor. The children are now getting personal attention and help in their studies in our study centre. Tests are also taken to assess the progress of the students. As a result, they are picking up well. The children range from class 1 to class 8. The children attend classes at the study centre

regularly. The popularity of the study centre is growing day by day. Also, some

children who are not enrolled in any school due to variety of reasons like lack of Aadhar card etc are coming to the centre regularly and are learning.

At the outset the children used to sit on mats on the floor to attend the classes.

Later on, in July 2023, thirty-two sets of



desks and benches, chairs & tables, books, uniforms, educational toys, blackboards, almirah, slides, pedestal fan etc were donated by Dr Poonam Singh, Principal of Blessed Hearts' School, Dum Dum Cantonment, Kolkata 700028 to Rajrappa Charitable Foundation.

Skilling:

Rajrappa Charitable Foundation has undertaken work of skilling the women and youth of the village.



Sewing and tailoring centre: Central Coalfields Limited, (CCL)
Rajrappa Project, Rajrappa has
donated 6 sewing machines, one
big cutting table, one white board
and 4 plastic stools to the
Foundation. The sewing and

tailoring training centre has started in one of the rooms of the Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill Centre Hensapora with the above donated items. The same was inaugurated on 14.11.2023 and the classes started on 22.11.2023. One instructor, a resident of Hensapora Village who is an expert in Cutting, Sewing and Tailoring has been hired on part time basis to provide training. A batch consists of 10 -12 students. The classes are being held in the afternoon. The course is of 3 months after which they are given certificates by Rajrappa Charitable Foundation. No fees are taken and the classes are absolutely free. The first batch for sewing and tailoring course successfully



completed the course at the Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill centre on 22.03.2024. 9 out of 10 students successfully completed the course. Certificates were handed over by Mrs Britteny Corrin Panda

to 9 students in a small function held at the centre. More than 50 students of the study centre were present and enjoyed the festivities. The subsequent batches of Sewing and Tailoring course are going on.





• **Beauty Parlour Training Centre**: - One room of the building has been converted into a Beauty Parlour by the owners and

handed over to Rajrappa Charitable Foundation for training of the village girls/women in Beauty Parlour work. One batch of 12 students have finished their training and awaiting their certificates. The second batch is in the

pipeline.



Events and Activities held at the Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill Centre:



- Independence Day 2023 was celebrated with much fanfare at the Study and Skill Centre. Shri Pradeep Modi, Eminent Lawyer, Jharkhand High Court was the chief guest. Notebooks, copies, pens and pencils were given to about 50 students of the study centre.
- About 108 saplings of those of Amla, Bel, Arjun, Haritaki, Bahera etc were bought from the Forest Department nursery at Gharkhatanga at Ranchi. Apart from these Aloe Vera, Moringa, Palm and other plants were also arranged.








Day, the volunteers, members and invitees planted these saplings in the compound of the Study and Skill centre. All of them, then made a procession through

the village with the medicinal plants to spread awareness regarding their importance. After that they planted several medicinal trees and herbs in the Primary Health Centre. Later throughout the week, the remaining plants were distributed to all interested persons for plantation in their homes and farmsteads.

• The foundation appealed to the local youth for volunteering. 14 volunteers have been enrolled by the foundation. They and other members participated actively in the tree plantation drive. 25 T-shirts bearing the logo of the foundation were distributed among these volunteers and other members who actively participated on Independence Day and tree plantation drive. The volunteers are also helping the foundation as and when required like





 Teacher's Day was celebrated at the Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill Centre on 5th of September. The students were shown a video clip on the history of Teacher's Day and about Hon'ble Dr S Radhakrishnan. Thereafter a quiz was held and prizes were given for each correct answer. The children participated energetically trying to answer the questions. They then showcased their talent through songs and dances

 A painting competition was held on 14.11.2023 on the occasion of Children's Day. All the students participated. They were divided into 3 groups and prizes were also announced for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and consolation positions for each group.









 All students of the Study Centre were given sweaters donated by Mrs Poonam Sinha in the month of December 2023. Year end was celebrated with the children at the

centre with food and sweets donated by Mrs Monica Panda.



Republic Day was celebrated with much enthusiasm. Major General D.K. Purohit, AVSM, SM, VSM (Retd) was the chief guest. Two brand new classrooms were inaugurated on Republic Day by Major General Purohit on Republic Day. The classes for the children of the Study Centre are now being held in these new classrooms.



 Counselling sessions for employability of the village youth have been undertaken by the foundation at the centre. The first counselling course for GDA Nursing Assistant was held at Hensapora on 27.05.2023. Counselling for a

multifunctional office associate course at this

study and skill centre at Hesapora was held on 9.09.2023. More than 20 persons attended each of these sessions. Counsellings were also held for Beauty Parlour training and Tailoring courses.



• Interactions were held with the various Women Self Help Groups of Village Hensapora. On 15.10.2023 all the self help groups of Hensapora about 23 in number were invited for discussion on making them self reliant. About 27 women of 9 groups participated in the meeting. The business of masala making was discussed with them in detail. They were very much interested and one group came forward for the business

 RCF Sports Academy: To cater to the development of sports activities among the local youth and children a separate wing has been created by Rajrappa Charitable Foundation, and named as 'RCF Sports Academy'. The creation of such a wing/platform was needed for promotion of sports culture as well as registration, affiliation and participation in various sports activities held at district/state/higher levels. RCF Sports Academy is registered with the Ramgarh Cricket Association. The cricket team has been formed by the RCF Sports Academy from among the youth of Hensapora village of Ramgarh district. RCF Academy participated in the B division league of Ramgarh District. The league matches started in January 2024. RCF Academy won the first match but lost the next matches of the league.

• Central Coalfields Limited has donated a pulverising machine for making masala to Rajrappa Charitable Foundation. The machine has been installed at the premises of the Shri Ram Krishna Panda Study and Skill Centre. A self-help group has been formed. They have been supported by the Foundation by initially giving raw masala for grinding. The same is to be sold and rolled again as the working capital for the business. A



demonstration of the machine has been given to the SHG.
