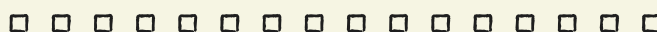

We love music! All of the instruments in our classes are as close to real as possible. We have a wide variety of instruments but some unconventional ones you'll find in our center are kalimbas, ukuleles, small guitars, and a full size piano. One of our favorites is a little tone drum (pictured), and it has such a beautiful sound!

While we typically use the word "play" to describe what we do with instruments that can be confusing to small children. Our job is to teach gentleness and playing with care when we use musical instruments. And it's such a great lesson to watch unfold! Our kiddos are learning patience and self control while also improving their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.

To keep kiddos participating in the F&G Program we have started our weekly indoor garden activities! All of our friends over age 1 have "planted" 2 different types of beans to watch them grow and experimented with pinecones. But what does all-weather play look like when the colder temps start blowing in? For the most part we layer up our older kiddos and go out, but for shorter amounts of time. And sometimes we just get to play inside! With the arctic-like temps our teachers have been getting creative with inside activities.

Pre-K
