My father, Olivier, took over the 10 hectares of his grandparent's land in 1984.

My brother, Baptiste and his Partner, Gaëlle, took over half of the vineyard in 2012 and started "Le Batossay" project:

Everything is worked by hand in the field with the help of our shire horses, following organic and biodynamic principles.

No chemicals or sulphate are added to the wine in the cellar, and only old vinification methods are used.

## *Cuvée Bavette*

The 2023 vintage presented an abundant harvest, leaving our family with more Cabernet Franc grapes than usual.

This led to the creation of Cuvée Bavette, using the surplus grapes.

Unlike the family's traditional cuvées, grapes for Cuvée Bavette were left with their stems during fermentation, resulting in a light to medium-bodied wine with a fruit-forward profile with notes of red berries, green peppers and an earthy undertone, typical of Cabernet Franc.

It is a lively red with a bit of spitz when opening, which helps to keep it fresh and fun; it is a perfect pairing for our bistro dishes.

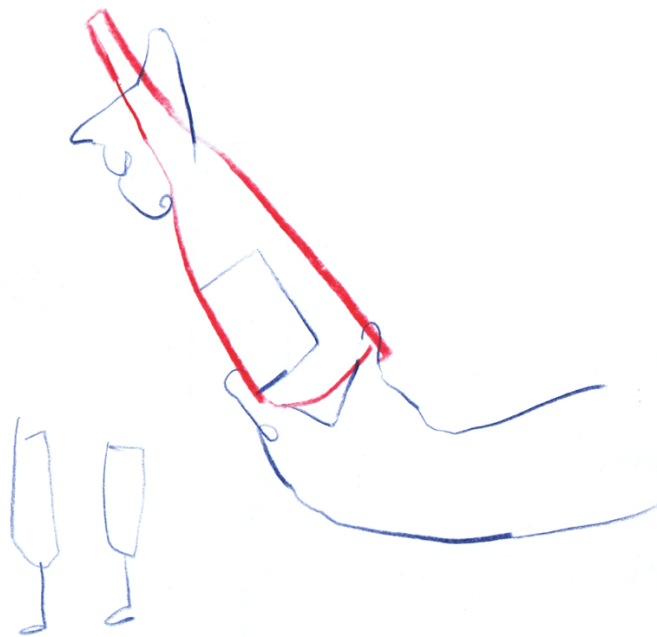
