
The double-edged sword in the center, also called a **Khanda**, represents the passage one takes through life as illustrated by the ten founding Gurus of Sikhi.


JULY 2ND 1606

There was not a cry raised from the spectators, but the lips of very many of them were moving in prayer... I can only describe the silence and the worship and the pain upon the faces of these people, who were seated in prayer, as reminding me of the shadow of the Cross. What was happening to them was truly, in some dim way, a crucifixion..."
