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Crochet Organizer Basket Pattern

Skill Level

- Easy- beginner friendly
- Requires basic knowledge

Supplies

- Bobbiny's 5mm braided cord
- 8mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Organizer Base, Top & Dividers
- 4 Stitch Markers
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- Ch-chain
- Sc-single crochet
- Inc-increase
- Wc- waistcoat stitch
- Inv Close- invisible close
- Inv Join-invisible join
- Blo-back loop only



Instructions

The wooden base comes in 4 sections, main base with 10mm holes, 2 dividers and the top piece.

Round 1 Leave Tail 12 inches long

Attach the cord to the main base starting from the top center hole (directly above the sun on the logo)

This will be hole #1

Add stitch markers in holes 11, 17, 37 and 43. This is where you will crochet the increases.

Hole 1: Pull up a loop and Ch 1

Holes 2-10: Sc

Hole 11: Inc

Holes 12-16: Sc

Hole 17: Inc

Holes 18-36: Sc

Hole 37: Inc

Holes 38-42: Sc

Hole 43: Inc

Holes: 44-51 Sc

Hole 52: Sc (pull up a loop with working cord, yarn over with tail and pull yarn all the way through)

Create Inv Close

Each round will have 56 stitches

Instructions

Round 2

In the last stitch (where the tail is sticking out)
Insert hook and pull up a loop, Ch 1 using working cord
Sc Blo (both back loops)
On last stitch, finish with tail and create invisible close (56)

Round 3

In last stitch (where the tail is sticking out) pull up a loop and Ch 1 with working cord

Wc (56)

Weave tail in to hide

Round 4-8 Invisible join Wc (56)

Round 9

Invisible join

Add divider pieces with the curved corners on the bottom then add top piece.

We around the top piece (56)

This can be tricky, after making about 5 Wc stitches the wooden pieces stay together.

Round 10

Sl St

Invisible Close, cut cord and weave in the end (56)

Optional: sew on handmade tag
