## ASSUMPTIONS

- The Bible is the inspired and authoritative Word of God and is the <u>only</u> reliable and accurate source for Christian doctrine and divine truth. It is self-interpreting, and is accessible to all – clearly expressed and easily understood by any serious reader.
- History and science corroborate much of Scripture but can never be the test of the validity of Scripture.
