

Evolution Dance Center Expectations

We want all of our dancers to feel at home while at EDC, but we also know to properly train your dancer to evolve we must conduct structured rehearsals. Below are a few rules and regulations we expect our dancers to follow!

1. **Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your scheduled rehearsal time.**

We understand life can get busy and sometimes we all just run a little behind, but we do ask that your dancer be 10 minutes early to get their shoes on and prepared for their instruction.

2. **While teachers are teaching please keep talking to a minimum.**

Though we wish we could talk all day with our dancers, there is a time and place. During instruction EDC teachers ask that we only talk when called on. If a dancer has a question please raise your hand to notify your instructor, unless otherwise specified. There will be times during rehearsal where we will gather and talk as a group so we can all get our chatter out!

3. **Dancers should abide by EDC's dress code**

Attached is also our dress code. Please come to practice in the proper attire as well as hair pulled back and out of your dancer's face.

4. **Dancers should keep their dance bags in the cubbies inside the lobby.**

There are cubbies located along the wall of our lobby for our dancer's to keep their bags! Water bottles are allowed into the studio with dancers, but we ask that all other belongings remain in the lobby.

5. **Cellphones are to stay in dancers' dance bags.**

We are all glued to our phones, but during class is not a time to be. Dancers will be able to check their phones between classes while changing shoes, if there is an emergency and you need to get in contact with your dancer please call the studio number.

6. **Please "Study" and do your "Homework"**

There will be days when class ends that your teacher will send home a study sheet or homework to complete before the next class. There are no grades, we just want to help our dancers evolve and continue instruction outside of the studio. These take home sheets will always only contain technique and skills we have learned in class.
