- -Participants will become more aware of reading the body language of others and themselves.
 - -Participants will better understand how to powerfully command a stage with their positioning, posture, and vocal choices.

Storytelling

- -Through our innate ability to tell stories, participants will learn to keep audiences engaged in all kinds of circumstances.
- -Participants will play games attempting to tell stories in groups, pairs, and individually, with an ever-changing set of rules and circumstances.
 - -This promotes confidence, teamwork, and public speaking skills.

Improv Scenes

- -Finally, all the skills practiced will be employed in creating completely brand-new and made up on-the-spot improvised scenes.
 - -Participants will be guided through each scene as needed.
