COVID-19 Update

• Lowest level (17 cases/day) of transmission for the Omicron wave. We have some test kits in stock and recommend everyone pick up some for your departments in case another wave of cases hits in the future. The ordering from the federal government system takes 2-3 weeks to arrive. Every Wednesday there is a vaccination clinic at the PCHD. No additional guidance, as of yet, for additional booster rounds – current recommendation is one booster (total of 3 shots).
