Questions have been asked why are the City Tournaments are so early this year. In the year that a local association hosts a State Tournament, they do not have to have their City Tournaments, but the Lafayette USBC felt that it is important to continue to try to have our local tournaments each and every year. The City tournaments have been split up into 2 parts, Singles & Doubles early, then Team Event later. This makes it to where not all the money is due at once, which allows for bowlers to bowl multiple times if they choose and it is allowed. You need 2 consecutive weekends to have the City Tournaments, so that is sometimes a problem with scheduling events with the centers as they all get busy starting in the fall thru the spring months.
