Qualifying will be 3 different challenge oil patterns across 6 lanes.

4th Pattern for Advancers Round & Finals.

Squads are limited to the first 45 bowlers each squad.

NO walk-ins within 30 minutes prior to start time. Draw for starting lane assignments. Men & Women will be on separate lanes when applicable.

4 Divisions

Open Division (Any age)

Open Senior Division (50 as of 8/1/2025)

Queen's Division (Any Age)

Senior Queens Division (50 as of 8/1/2025)

Youth Bowlers are allowed. See rules for qualifications

Saturday, October 18th (2#) QUALIFYING SQUADS:

1pm & Approximately 5:00pm As soon as we re-oil after squad 1.

Top ½ of each division per squad advances.

Pin total from Saturday WILL carry over to Sunday's Advancers round.

Sunday, October 19th - **11am**- Advancers Round.

Bowl 3 games on 4th pattern, moving after each game.

We will cut to a top 4 match play in each division.

1 vs 4 in a 1 game match

2 vs 3 in a 1 game match

2 winners meet in a 2 game total pinfall Championship Match



FORMAT:

(2#) QUALIFYING Squads on Saturday October 18th. Everyone will bowl 6 games across 3 pairs. 2 games on each pair, with a total of 3 different challenge patterns. We will cut to the top 1/2 **from each of the (2#)** qualifying squads, per division. In a squad with **5** or less entries in any one division, everyone will move on to the advancers round. **Tournament director reserves the right to make adjustments to advancing numbers based on overall entries per division.**

Total pins **WILL** carry over to Sunday. Everyone bowls together during Qualifying rounds and Advancer's round. You are only competing against bowlers in your division, not necessarily against everyone on your pair of lanes you are qualifying on.

Advancers round Sunday, October 19th: 11AM - Bowl 3 more games on a 4th challenge pattern.

You will move after each game. The top 4 qualifiers based on the 9 game total pinfall will advance to match play. This pattern will also be used for the Stepladder Finals.

Finals: Match Play Format. 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3, 1 game matches.

The 2 winners will bowl a 2 game total pinfall final for the championship.

2025/2026 LAFAYETTE USBC CITY MASTERS & QUEENS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entry is open to all eligible adult members of the Lafayette USBC Association. Entrants must have bowled at least **(9#)** games this season in any sanctioned league(s) in the Lafayette USBC Association. Exceptions can be made by the Tournament manager for certain circumstances.
2. Lafayette Youth Sanctioned bowlers who are High School Freshman or older(2025/26 season) can bowl in this event. Youth entrants must have bowled at least **(9#)** games this season in any sanctioned youth league(s) or High School competition in the Lafayette USBC Association. Boys will bowl in the Open division, girls will bowl in the queens division. Exceptions can be made by the Tournament manager for certain circumstances. Any prize money won will go into their Smart account.
3. The Lafayette USBC City Masters & Queens is a **SCRATCH** tournament.
4. Senior division is open to anyone 50 years old as of 08/01//2025.
5. A senior bowler may bowl in either regular **OR** the senior's division, not both.
6. Entry Fee = **\$65.00 Cash or Check.** + \$2 for Credit Cards. On or before October 16th, 8pm
7. Walk-in entries will be accepted at **\$70 cash or \$72 paying by credit card. After October 16th.**
8. **\$65 re-entry fee** or **\$67** by credit card.
9. Bowlers can bowl both qualifying squads but will use the scores from the squad they advance in.
10. Protests will follow USBC rule #329.
11. The tournament prize ratio is at least 1 in 5 with 100% of the prize fund returned.
12. All ties **can** be decided with a (9th & 10 frame roll off, highest pinfall wins)
13. Any champion not wishing to accept the entry into one of the Indiana State Masters or Queens tournaments may take a free entry into NEXT years Lafayette USBC Masters & Queens, or state singles events.
14. ***Code of Conduct will be enforced. This is the Lafayette USBC premier event. Please dress and act accordingly!!!! No Exceptions. Pictures will be taken of the champions afterwards, so dress like you are planning on winning please.***
