Responsible for responding to calls relayed by Dispatcher including domestic disputes, assaults, burglaries, traffic accidents and others. Conducts preliminary investigations and field interviews. Contacts investigator if needed. Testifies and presents evidence in court proceedings; completes reports; apprehends, arrests, and processes offenders.

Possess or have the ability to obtain Alabama Peace Officer's Standards and Training Commission minimum standard certificate
